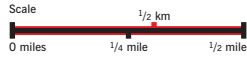


## Carsington Water Map

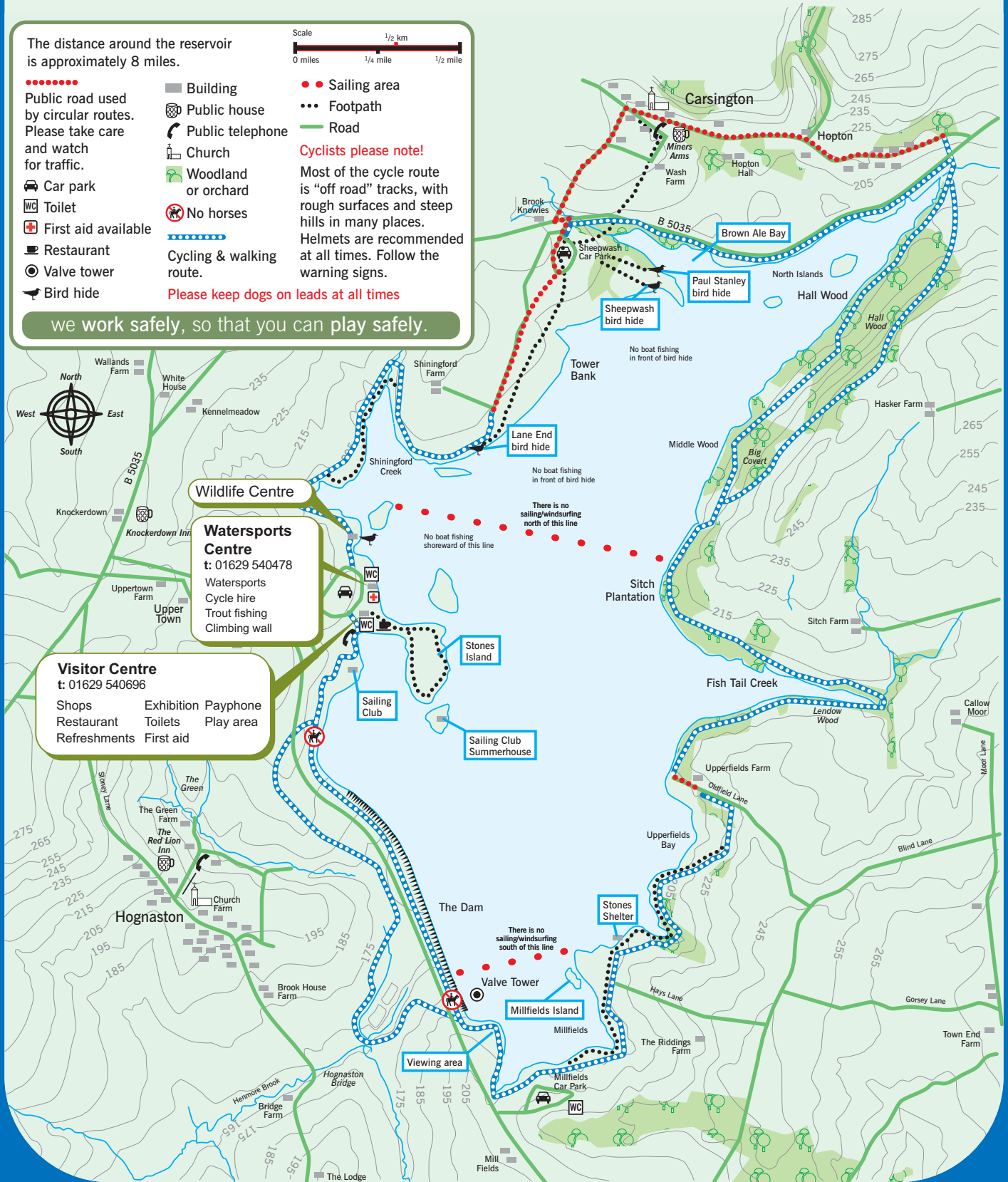
