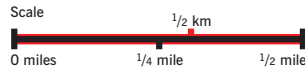


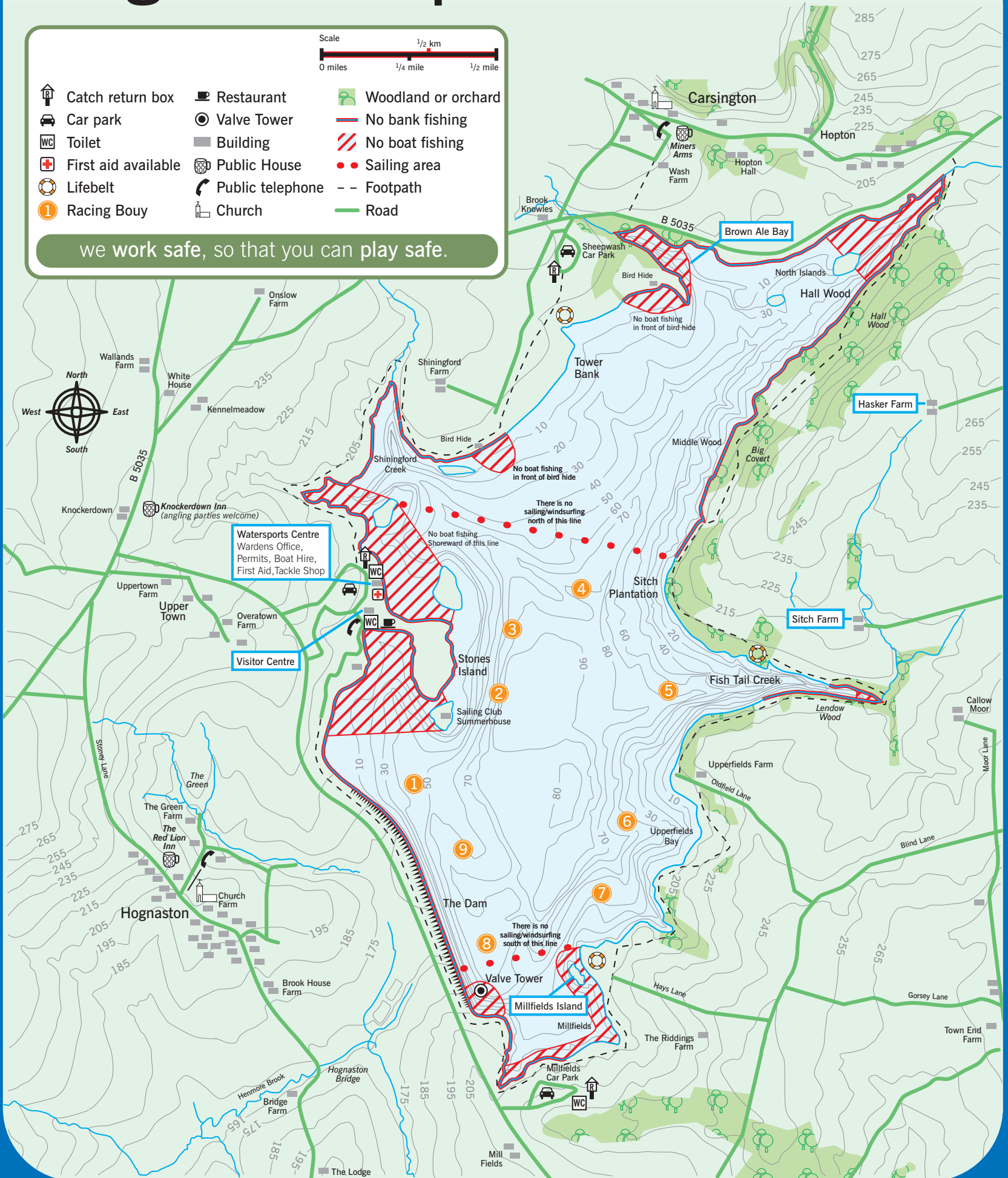
Angler's Map
